The first of these responses will be in the form of **a Just Transition Framework in 2022** which will be a plan for achieving a just and equitable transition to net-zero CO<sub>2</sub> emissions in South Africa and set out the actions that social partners will take over the short-, medium, and long-run.

The Just Transition Framework presents an opportunity to start dealing with issues relating to governance mechanisms, economic diversification tools, labour market interventions, and social support.
